

Press brief on Transformation of Aspirational Block Programme (TABP)

The Government of Tripura launched the Transformation of Aspirational Block Programme (TABP) in 24th September, 2019 to accelerate improvement in the socio-economic indicators of the most under developed blocks of the State. Currently the programme is being implemented in 12 most interior tribal blocks with an aims to expeditiously transform the quality lives of tribal population and infrastructure of block areas that have been identified from 58 blocks across the State. The initiative focuses on the strength of each block, and identifies the attainable outcomes for immediate improvement, while measuring progress and ranking the selected blocks.

The Transformation of Aspirational Block Programme (TABP) is the collective effort of identified departments and TTAADC, although at State level, Rural Development Department is the Nodal Agency for driving the progress, achievement as per target and effective monitoring of the programme.

Last meeting under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Tripura was held on 24/06/2021 at 11.30AM in the Secretariat Conference hall No-2, where the performance of Aspirational Blocks was reviewed on the basis of key performance indicators (data points) in 9 primary sectors namely Health, Education, Agriculture & Horticulture, Fishery, Animal husbandry, Rural development including Panchayat, Drinking Water, sanitation and Rural Electrification, Social welfare & Nutrition and Information Technology.

The Aspirational Block Programme was also reviewed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Tripura on 25/06/2021 at 2PM in Secretariat Conference hall No-2 with the Chief Secretary and other Secretaries of line Departments.

On the basis of key performance indicators in Transformation of Aspirational Block Programme (TABP), RD Department has arranged the delta ranking of Aspirational Blocks as appended below:
