## Press brief on Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) houses to be sanctioned during 2021-22 FY

Recently Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has sanctioned 1,59,913 houses under PMAY(G) during FY 2021-22 to saturate permanent wait list from SECC–2011 data after change in definition of kutcha house.

The eligibility criteria of beneficiary to get a PMAY-G house during FY 2021-22 are as follows-

- i) Enlisted under SECC-2011.
- ii) The existing house of beneficiary is having Kutcha wall & GCI Sheet roofing.
- iii) No family member of beneficiary is Government employee.
- iv) No housing assistance from any Government schemes received earlier.

State has completed 87% survey of kutcha houses verifications as per eligible beneficiaries list provided by Ministry and remaining survey work will be completed by 25.08.2021. The draft priority list of eligible beneficiaries surveyed till 05.08.2021 has been published in all GPs/VCs offices on 09.08.2021. The draft GP/VC wise priority list (Phase-I) as survey is yet to be finalized has also been published on the concerned district websites.

A special Gram Sabha will be held across the state on 14.08.2021 to finalize the recommended list of eligible beneficiaries for PMAY-G houses after verification of the priority list by Gram Sabha. The recommended list of eligible beneficiaries by Gram Sabha will be published on 16.08.2021. The claims and objections against recommended list can be submitted in GP/VC or block or district office by 23.08.2021. The claims and objections against recommended list of the Gram Sabha will be heard and disposed by district level appellate committee by 03.09.2021. The final priority list of eligible beneficiaries for sanctioning PMAY-G houses (Phase-I) will be published on 05.09.2021.

The Households whose survey of kutcha houses verifications will be completed in between 06.08.2021 to 25.08.2021 the similar process will be taken up to prepare their final priority list of eligible beneficiaries for sanctioning PMAY-G houses during the month of September,2021 in Phase-II.
